

FUNO ANNOUNCES THE RELEASE OF ADDITIONAL CBFIS

Mexico City, Mexico June 26, 2017. - Fibra Uno (BMV: FUNO11) ("FUNO" or "Fideicomiso F/1401"), the first and largest Real Estate Investment Trust in Mexico announces that, effective on June 21, 2017, it released 7,416,350 CBFIs related to the acquisition of the Alaska Portfolio.

FUNO announces the release of 7,416,350 CBFIs that are outstanding, and that represent 5% of the total acquisition price of the Alaska portfolio, announced on December 15, 2015. These CBFIs were placed in escrow and were released once all the closing conditions were met. During the time those CBFIs were in escrow there were neither economic nor corporate rights.

Therefore, FUNO's total current outstanding CBFIs are 3,289,543,506.
